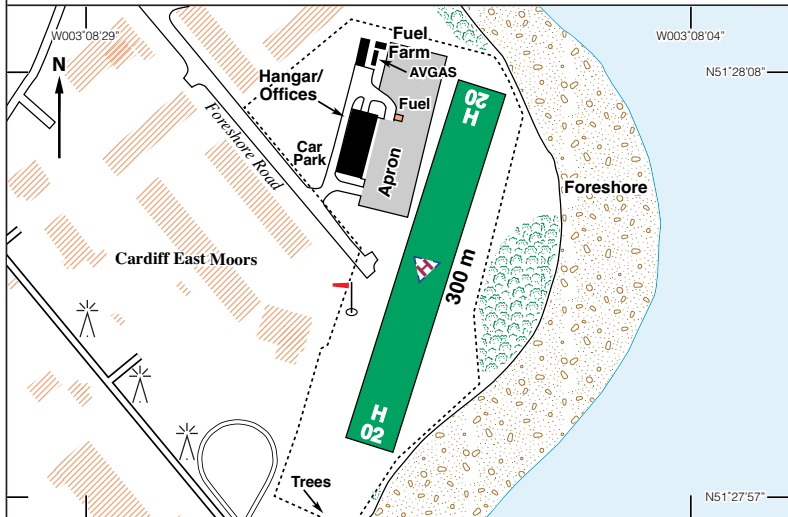

Landing and Taking off within congested areas:

When a landing or take-off is intended at Cardiff Heliport which is situated within a congested area, compliance with the following procedures is required under SERA.3105. Minimum heights and as notified under Rules of the Air Regulations 2015 Rule 5(1)(a).

**Remarks (Continued)****Notified Procedures:**

(a) Landing and take-off shall only be performed with the permission of the person in charge of the aerodrome;

(b) Except when necessary for take-off or landing at the aerodrome, aircraft shall not be flown over the congested area unless such a height as will permit, in the event of an emergency arising, including a critical engine failure, a landing is to be made without undue hazard to persons or property on the surface. This height shall be at least 300m (1000ft) above the highest obstacle within a radius of 600m from the aircraft; and

(c) Approach and departure shall be made over clear areas so that a safe forced landing can be achieved in the event of an engine failure.

All inbound helicopters must first contact Cardiff Radar on 119.150, and immediately after departure.

Circuit direction: 02 RH / 20 LH. Avoid overflight of fuel storage tanks starboard side on Rwy 20 climbout.

**Warnings:** Trees/bushes - North, South and South East boundary up to 60ft amsl and on Eastern boundary up to 100ft amsl.

Street lighting (U/S) on 20 TOC / 02 APP, 68ft amsl.

Security fence surrounds the site at 7 ft agl

Windsleeve and weather station 55 ft amsl on the western perimeter.

Static fuel unit 45 ft amsl on the North edge of the apron.
